The annual Children's Book Festival helps spread the enjoyment of books and reading among children and families, authors and illustrators, teachers and librarians all over Ireland.

This year Libraries all over the country have moved events online so that children may still connect with authors, books, and storytelling.

To celebrate Children's Book Festival 2020, Cavan County Library is delighted to introduce 2 wonderful authors, and an inspiring storyteller into the classrooms of all 80 schools in the county!

For the younger classes, author **Natasha Mac a'Bháird** will share the inspirational life story of one of Ireland's greatest ever athletes, as portrayed in her new book for children, **'Sonia O'Sullivan'**.

For the older classes, Cavan author **Dave Rudden** will present **'Master of Monsters'** – a guide to how to tell your own terrifying stories.

Classes have already been asked to submit questions to both authors which will be streamed live in the classroom during the month of October. Pupils and teachers alike are thus afforded the chance to listen to real live authors discuss their books!.

Our storyteller this year is the wonderful Chris Thompson. Chris has come aboard to tell Halloween stories to all the primary school pupils with the help of seasonal props and her lovable puppets.

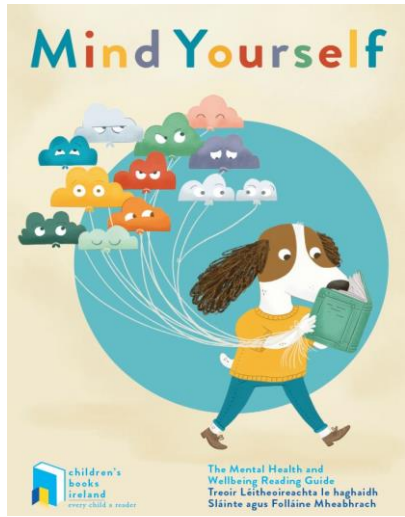
Level 5 Restrictions Cavan Libraries

'Mind Yourself' Reading Guide

The 'Mind Yourself' reading guide contains reviews and recommendations of over 400 books for children and young people from birth to age eighteen and is designed as a 'first-aid kit' for worries, sadness, loneliness, anxiety and any number of feelings that a young person may want to explore during these anxious times of COVID 19!



The guide contains mental health and wellbeing information from Jigsaw and ISPCC Childline, including tips and coping strategies for young people and advice for adults on supporting children to build resilience.
