Cavan County Council has opened an online book of condolences for the late John Hume who passed away on 3rd August last. Cathaoirleach of Cavan County Council Councillor Sarah O'Reilly is inviting the public to express their condolences to the family of Nobel Laureate and former leader of the Social Democratic and Labour Party (SDLP). John Hume played a major role in the peace process, from the Anglo-Irish Agreement in 1985 to the Good Friday Agreement in 1998. He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1998.
