Free Book Bags for all Children starting School this September 2022

Is your child starting school this September? If so, then Cavan Library Service has great news!

The '**My Little Library Book Bag'** initiative, a collaboration between libraries and the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth as part of the First 5 Strategy, offers a **FREE** 'My Little Library Book Bag' for every child starting school in 2022 to help them to prepare for this big step.

Children and their parents or guardians can collect the bags at any library throughout Cavan. Each bag contains three books, especially selected, on starting school, making friends and being comfortable to be yourself. There is also a guide for parents and guardians, and a special library card wallet where your child can keep their library card for visits to the library! Book bags are available in both Irish and English.
